Anyone who has had or has had a family member or just to know someone with this terrible disease knows how important this contribution can be. I will have a money jar at the entry table for contributions. Any charitable donation that you receive for research will go to KS01. This will all be turned in at State Finals during May. You should be receiving your Spring Fund raiser of Pastry Puffins information by April 6. Since there is no show in April these orders will need to be mailed, faxed or emailed to me no later than April 24. The orders will be delivered at the May 3 show in Oskaloosa.

STATE FINAL Entry Forms are now on line, www.ksnbha.com. Print off the entry form, fill it out and mail it back to Dawn along with your check postmarked no later than April 18, 2009. Vet and medical releases accepted through May 9, 2009.

The district match race runners will be Jodi Pedersen, Gladys Rogers, Kori Conley and Billy Trout. The entry fee of \$100 will be paid by KS01.

During the state finals KS01 will have a silent auction table. There are several members showing an interest so here's the deal. We will have baskets, buckets, boxes, whatever, filled with items that pertain to a theme. A basket with the theme of baking a cake for instance, (a shaped baking pan, spatulas, spoons, sparkles, candles, decorations, cupcake papers, towels to wipe hands, anything in the cooking isle or that might be used in making a cake) use your imagination. You can also ask stores to donate/sponsor this. All members are to donate something that can be placed in a basket with a theme. I seen this done last weekend and there was a lot of participation. If you have any questions just ask me. Bring all donations to either the May 3 or May 17 show that will give time to put them together and have ready for State Finals.

KS01 work schedule for finals is the In/Out Gates on Friday, May 22, from 5:00 pm until done. One person for each gate a total of 2 people will be needed. After the draw is posted I will be asking for volunteers to work 30 minute time slots at either gate. I believe this will be during the youth race.

The Janet Stover Clinic, April 18-19 is beginning to fill up. If you are interested in coming you need to get your deposit to me. There will be an open jackpot on Friday night, April 17 beginning with warm-ups at 7:00, followed by Youth and Open.

As of now I have scheduled no shows for April. There is no indoor arena available and the weather is too iffy to schedule outside.

There has been discussion regarding the added money show that KS01 has been having the weekend of Labor Day. That weekend will not be available this year so the suggestion was made to move it to October and have it at Lawrence. In order to have this race with added money equal to or close to the amount in the past each member will be asked to donate \$25.00 (equal to one open entry fee) in addition to sponsors. This race is one of the big money makers for the awards. All members will have 6 months to save for this contribution. Again, if you have any questions please ask me.
